
## TACKLING COLORADO'S HOUSING NEEDS DELORES PROJECT AND COLORADO ACCESS

In 2019, Colorado ranked **10th** overall in the U.S. News & World Report's annual Best States Rankings, with an impressive first place ranking for its economy; however, Colorado is ranked **43rd** with regards to housing costs, making it one of the least affordable states in the U.S. Colorado Access has partnered with the Delores Project, which aims to provide affordable housing for low-income individuals. The Delores Project provides 35 units of low-income permanent supportive housing and 95 units of affordable housing for individuals and families in the workforce. Colorado Access offers one-on-one support to access physical and behavioral services for these individuals.

## **Assessing the Need**


The Arizona Self Sufficiency Matrix was administered to 16 participants to assess basic needs for individuals, on a five-point Likert scale, when they initiated their housing at the Delores Project.



## Outcomes



**Care Management** (May 2019 - Ongoing) The Care Management team at Colorado Access has provided individuals with one-on-one support to access physical health services.





**Telehealth** (June 2020 - Ongoing) Telehealth services are offered within the Delores Project housing unit to provide easy access care for behavioral health.
